## Blackbird Vineyards Returns to Premiere Napa Valley to Showcase its Tenth-Anniversary Cuvee Auction Crushes Previous Records, Raising Nearly \$6 Million

(NAPA VALLEY, CA; March 3, 2014)—This past Saturday, the Napa Valley Vintners' annual wine futures auction pulled in \$5.9 million in just over three hours of high-octane bidding on 225 one-of-a-kind, trade-only wine lots. Nearly doubling 2012's record of \$3.1 million, this year's event brought the annual fundraiser over the \$5 million milestone for the first time since its inception.

Blackbird Vineyards' singular lot, a 2012 vintage "tenth-anniversary cuvee" blend of 70% Cabernet Franc from Hudson Vineyard, 25% Merlot from Stagecoach Vineyard, and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon from Ballard Spring Mountain Vineyard, ranked in the top percentage for ten-case lots auctioned. The barrel lot garnered a winning bid of \$24,000 from Randy Gillespie of Haven Restaurant in Houston, Texas. At \$200 per bottle, the 2012 Blackbird Vineyards cuvee sold for 60% more than Blackbird's highly-rated Illustration, Paramour and Contrarian proprietary red wines.

"Premiere's auction success shows a positive trend in investing in premium Napa Valley wines," says Blackbird Vineyards' Founder, Michael Polenske. "We are honored that the results of our lot put us as a top auction lot and allowed us to be an integral part of the Napa Valley Vintners' efforts for our eighth consecutive year."

The vintner events leading up to Saturday's auction were considered "must attend" tasting opportunities for influential trade, such as retailers, restaurateurs, distributors, and media. Blackbird Vineyards kicked off Premiere week with an open house reception at Ma(i)sonry Napa Valley on Friday afternoon, featuring wines from Blackbird Vineyards, as well as fellow vintner partners – Casa Piena, Coup de Foudre, Juslyn Vineyards, Lail Vineyards, Pahlmeyer, Pedras Wine Company, R.A. Harrison Family Cellars, Renteria Wines, TOR Kenward Family Wines, Tuck Beckstoffer Wines.
